### **Nomination of candidates for President-Elect and Vice President 1 of EURO**

At the EURO Council meeting in Melbourne (scheduled for the 10 July) we need to elect a new President-Elect and a new Vice President 1. The Executive Committee (EC) has decided to schedule the process this year a bit different. The reason is that with a conference in Australia the cost of participation might deter people from participating. We will then get a significantly smaller council than normal (a situation we also saw in Sandton, South Africa three years ago). The EC believes that the election of officers in such a case should be set up so that the higher traveling cost is not obstacle for voting. Therefore we will after the nomination process extra-ordinary allow societies to cast their vote electronically.


Therefore after the nomination process, which is initiated by this letter, we will send out a list of candidates and their CV. The national societies can then vote electronically by email until 1 July. The casted votes will be carried forward to the EURO Council and added to the votes casted in the EURO Council. An electronic vote will be canceled if the EURO representative of a national society votes at the EURO Council.

To allow time for the nomination and electronic voting the process has been brought forward a bit. I therefore call upon the societies to nominate candidates for President-Elect and Vice President 1. According to the statutes for President-Elect the candidate must have written support of their own national society and in addition nominations from at least three national societies, for Vice President 1 beside support of their own national society a nomination letter from at least one other national society is required.

### **Deadline for nomination is 14 April, 2011 at 5pm CET.**
